

2010 Sunnybrae Pony Club Points Information Sheet

This year you will earn points by attending Rallys (mounted or unmounted), by doing special jobs around the Club or by participating in Metropolitan Zone or PCASA events.

NOTE: If a riding members receives two warning letters from the Pony Club what are upheld following all appeal processes, that rider will be ineligible for the High Point competition after the first warning and ineligible for any trophy or award if there is a second warning letter issued throughout the year.

Rally Points (Points Steward Lesley Russell-Bowering)

Points will be allocated at each rally as follows:

For mounted participation (maximum total 15 Points)

Presenting to instructor on time for your class - 2 points

Correct uniform:

- jumper/windcheater if required - 1 point
- club gold polo shirt with new logo or white shirt and tie - 1 point
- correct boots (short for Juniors unless they have C certificate, long OK for seniors) - 1 point
- jodhpurs (beige for juniors getting quallies, beige or dark OK for seniors) - 1 point
- Name tag or name embroidered on polo shirt - 1 point.

Cleanliness of gear - clean saddle and bridle (and in good repair), clean bit and clean saddle blanket - 1 point (if any part not clean - 0 points)

Cleanliness of horse (need not be washed), well groomed with clean eyes and nose - 1 point

Feet picked and hooves oiled - 1 point

Whips - Juniors with C certificate and Seniors can use dressage whips, juniors with anything under C (D, D star or no certificate) can only use whip 75cm or under.

Instructor then allocates points up to 5 for your contribution and attitude in class (0 being unsatisfactory to 5 for outstanding).

For unmounted participation (total 7 points)

Correct uniform:

- jumper/windcheater if required - 1 point
- club gold polo shirt with new logo or white shirt and tie - 1 point
- correct boots (short for Juniors unless they have C certificate, long OK for seniors) - 1 point
- jodhpurs (beige for juniors getting quallies, beige or dark OK for seniors) - 1 point
- name tag or name embroidered on polo shirt - 1 point.

Punctuality - arriving at start of rally and staying for entire session - 1 point

Assisting instructor or helping in Canteen - 1 point

Competition Points

For mounted participation - for attending with your horse in full and correct uniform - 15 points. Placings: 1st = 6 points; 2nd = 5 points; 3rd = 4 points; 4th = 3 points; 5th = 2 points and 6th - 1 point. Champion = 8 points. Reserve Champion = 6 points. Placings must be clearly marked on Competition Points Record Sheet.

For unmounted participation - for attending in uniform (that is gold polo shirt, brown windcheater or zip-up jacket, rugby top, beige or dark jodhpurs or brown v-necked jumper, white shirt and tie), for at least 3 hours of the day - 7 points.

For working $\frac{1}{2}$ a day (1/2 day is one session either morning or afternoon) - 2 points.

Working full day (that is through a morning and into an afternoon session) 5 points.

Committee points

The Committee reserves the right to allocate additional bonus points at their discretion to members who perform above and beyond the call of duty or who contribute to the Club in exceptional ways. These points will only be allocated if the Committee agree unanimously with the nomination.

Points totals will be kept confidential throughout the year.

How points will be gathered

Lesley Russell-Bowering will collect points on Rally days in consultation with the Instructor.

To have points recorded for your Competition involvement, you **MUST** complete a points record form which you'll find in filing drawer/tray in the canteen (or email sunnybraeponyclub@hotmail.com and we'll email the form to you) This must be given to Leah Bartley within 7 days of the event. It is **YOUR** responsibility to put **YOUR** point sheet in. No sheet - no points.

Age groupings

Juniors will be those aged under 18 years as at 1st January 2010. Seniors for the High Point score competition will be those aged 18 years and over as at 1st January 2010.

Closing date for points

Points will be accumulated up to 31st October 2010. Any Zone events or point scoring rallies held between 1st November and 31st December will go into 2011 points.
